IGEM Research Framework

1. Background

A formal Queensland (Qld) research framework will:

- Provide a coordinated approach to undertaking, managing and sharing research for the Qld context;
- 2. Support the development of research priorities and guiding principles;
- 3. Promote engagement between government and the tertiary sector through collaborative spaces and research forums; and
- 4. Promote transitions between research and practice.

2. Purpose

The purpose of the Research Framework is to collaboratively develop and promote research, for the Queensland context, for coal face disaster management practitioners, nurturing enhanced partnerships, cooperation and understanding between academic institutions and government agencies.

The development of people, processes, technology and content under the Framework will support the transition between research and practice in Qld's disaster management sector.

3. Goals

The goals are to:

- Develop a coordinated approach to undertaking, managing and sharing research;
- Support knowledge conversion processes within and external to IGEM;
- Support the development of strategic research priorities for the disaster management sector;
- Promote engagement between government and the tertiary sector; and
- Promote transitions between research and practice.

4. Key Audiences

The Framework has three key audiences:

- The Office of the Inspector-General Emergency Management;
- The Queensland Disaster Management Sector the practitioners and end-users; and
- The Research Sector Universities.

5. Next Steps

IGEM will engage with the disaster management and tertiary sectors to:

- map existing research;
- identify gaps and opportunities for collaboration between the sectors; and
- set research priorities and guiding principles for Qld.
