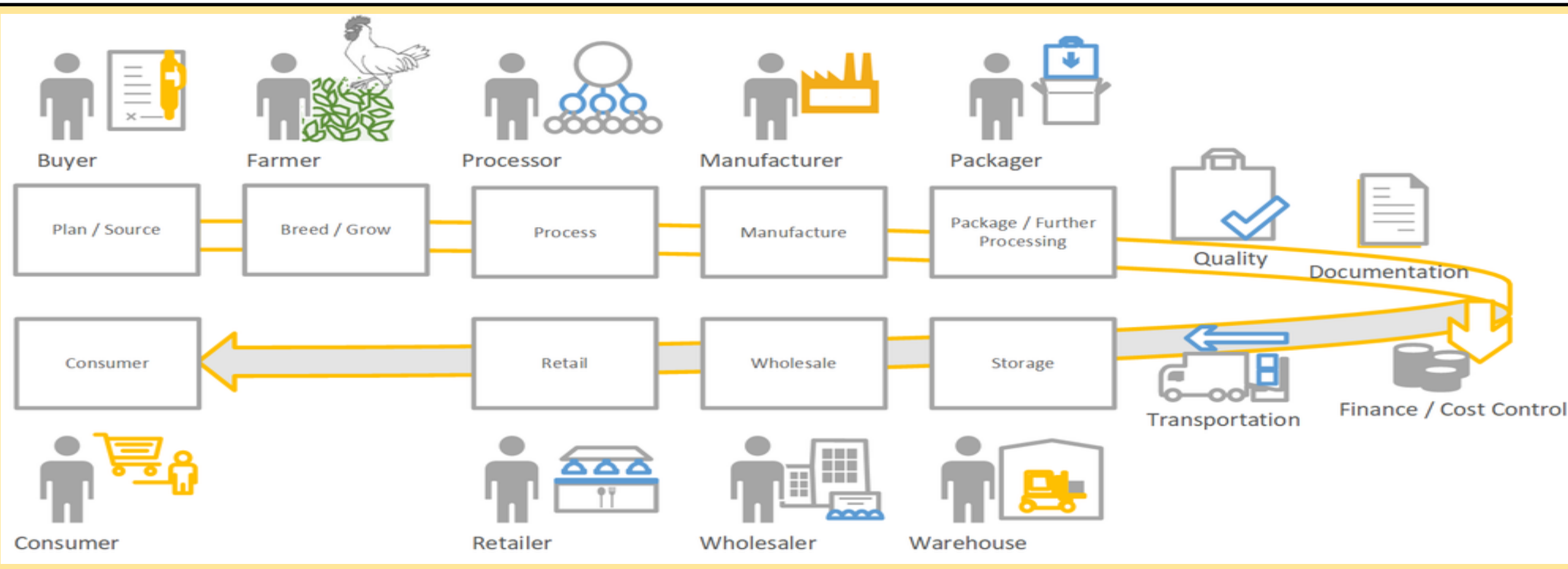

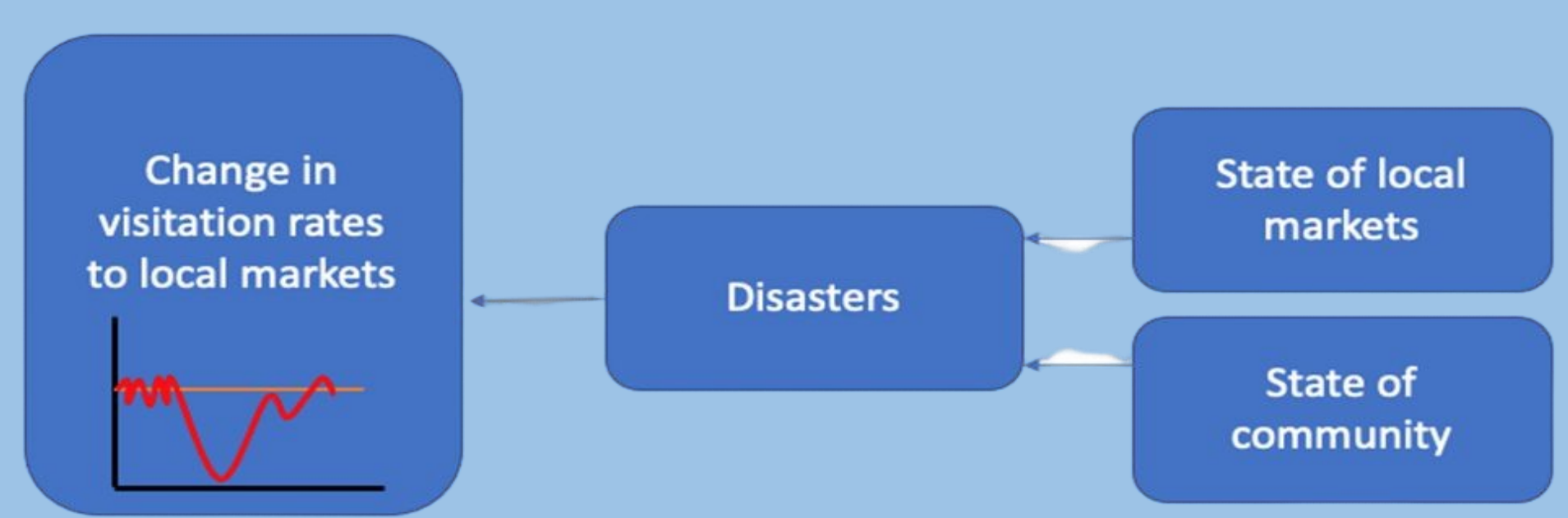
Food insecurity

Disasters challenge all elements of food security



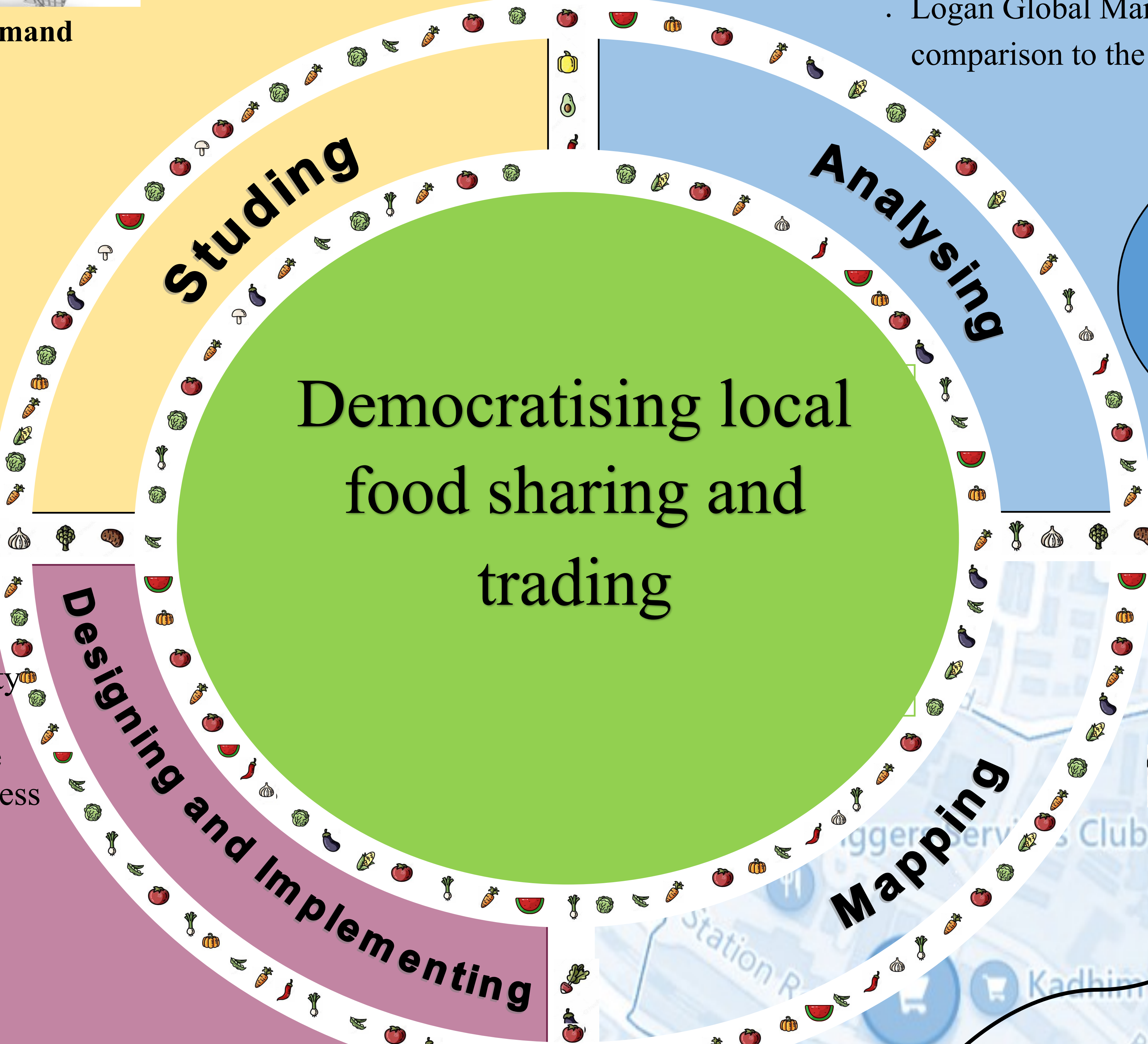
Short Food supply Chain is a part of the solution to enhance the food security.



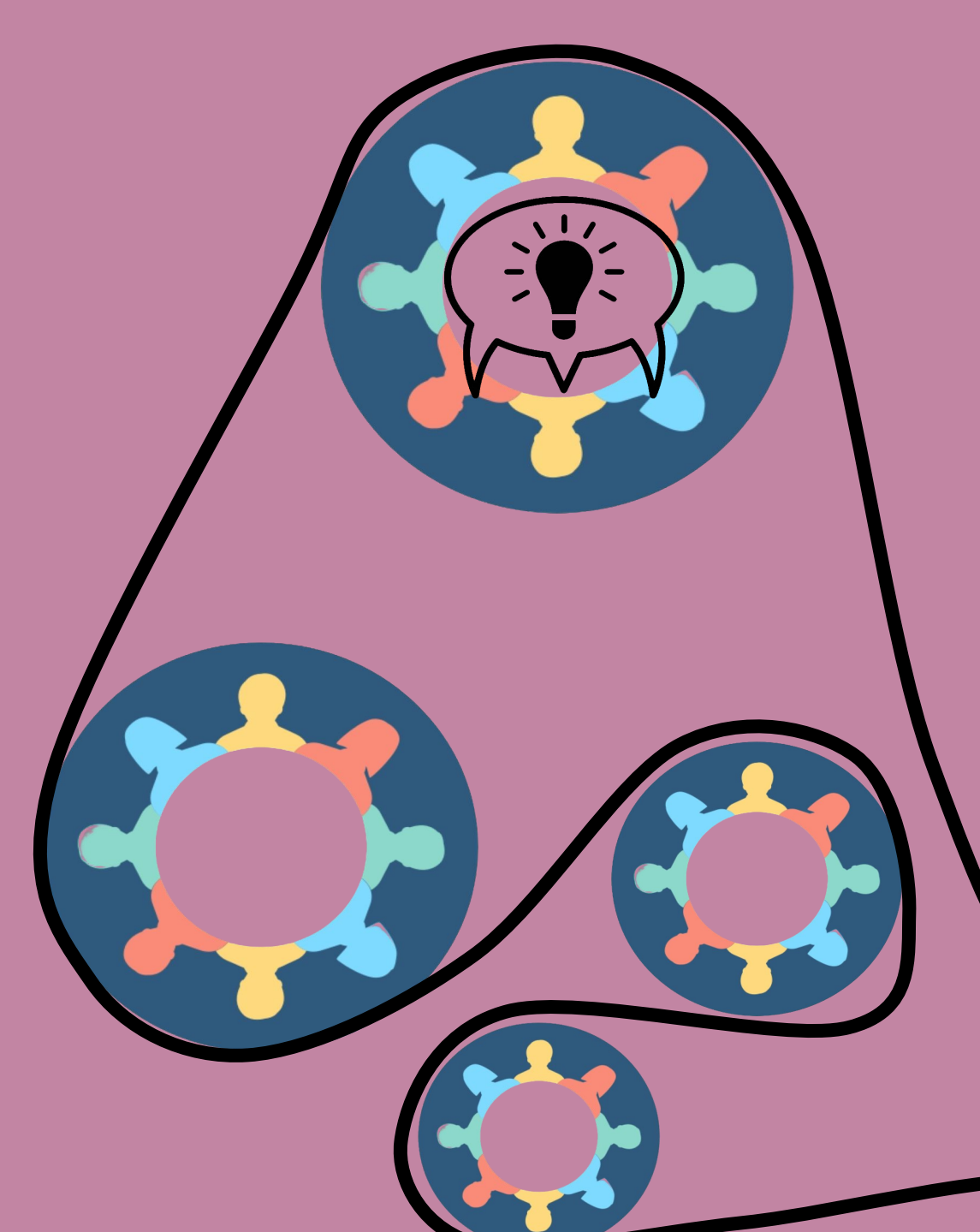
What is happening during disasters to local markets in the case study ?

 - The state of local markets was impacted.
 - Logan Global Market was heavily impacted in comparison to the Brisbane Rocklea Market .

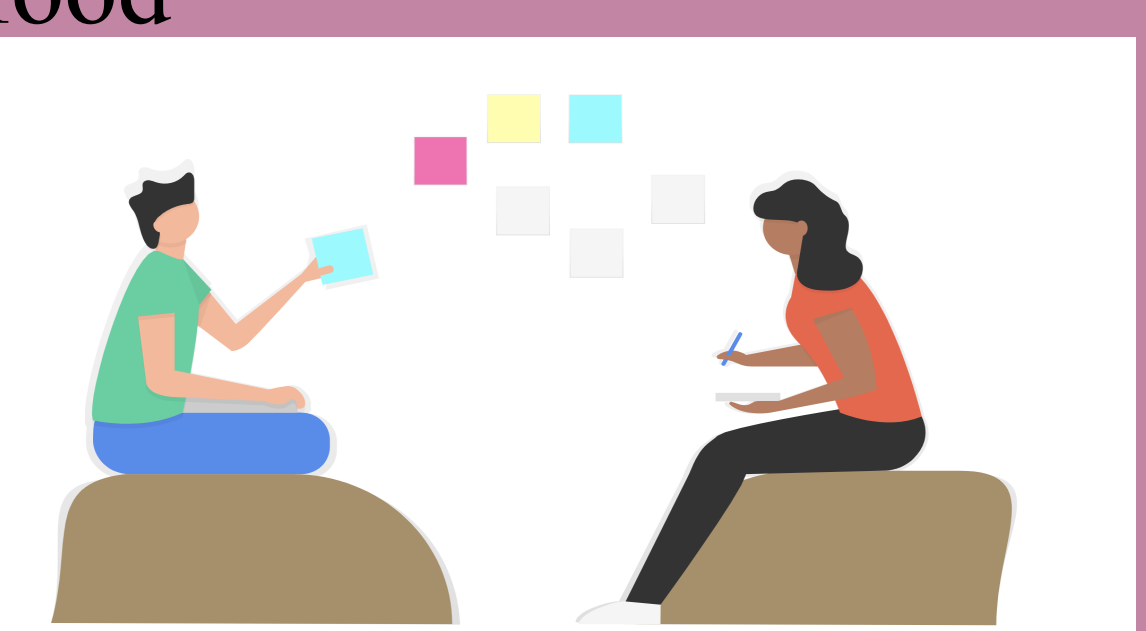
These impacts led to an investigation to: How does community access local food?
